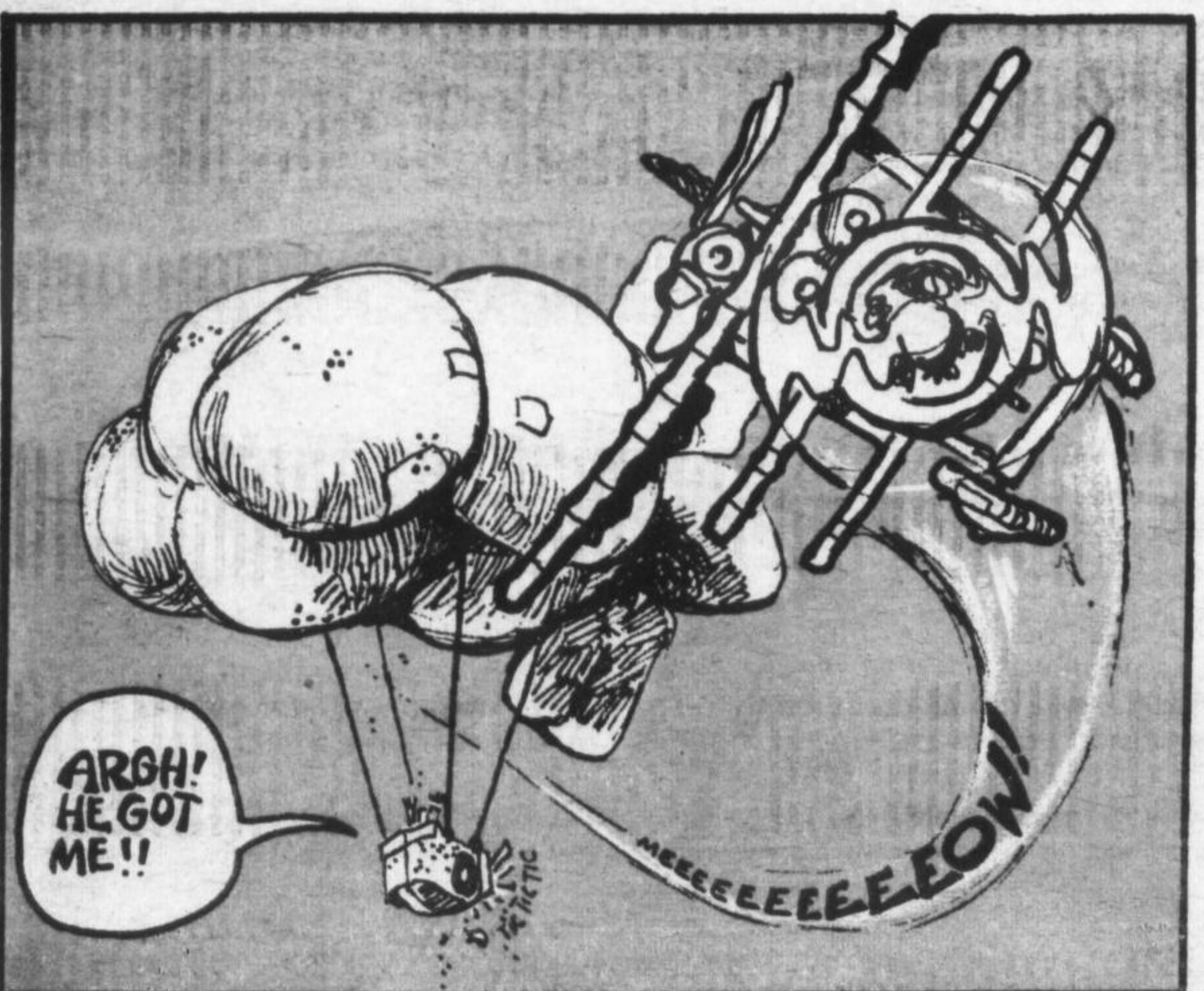
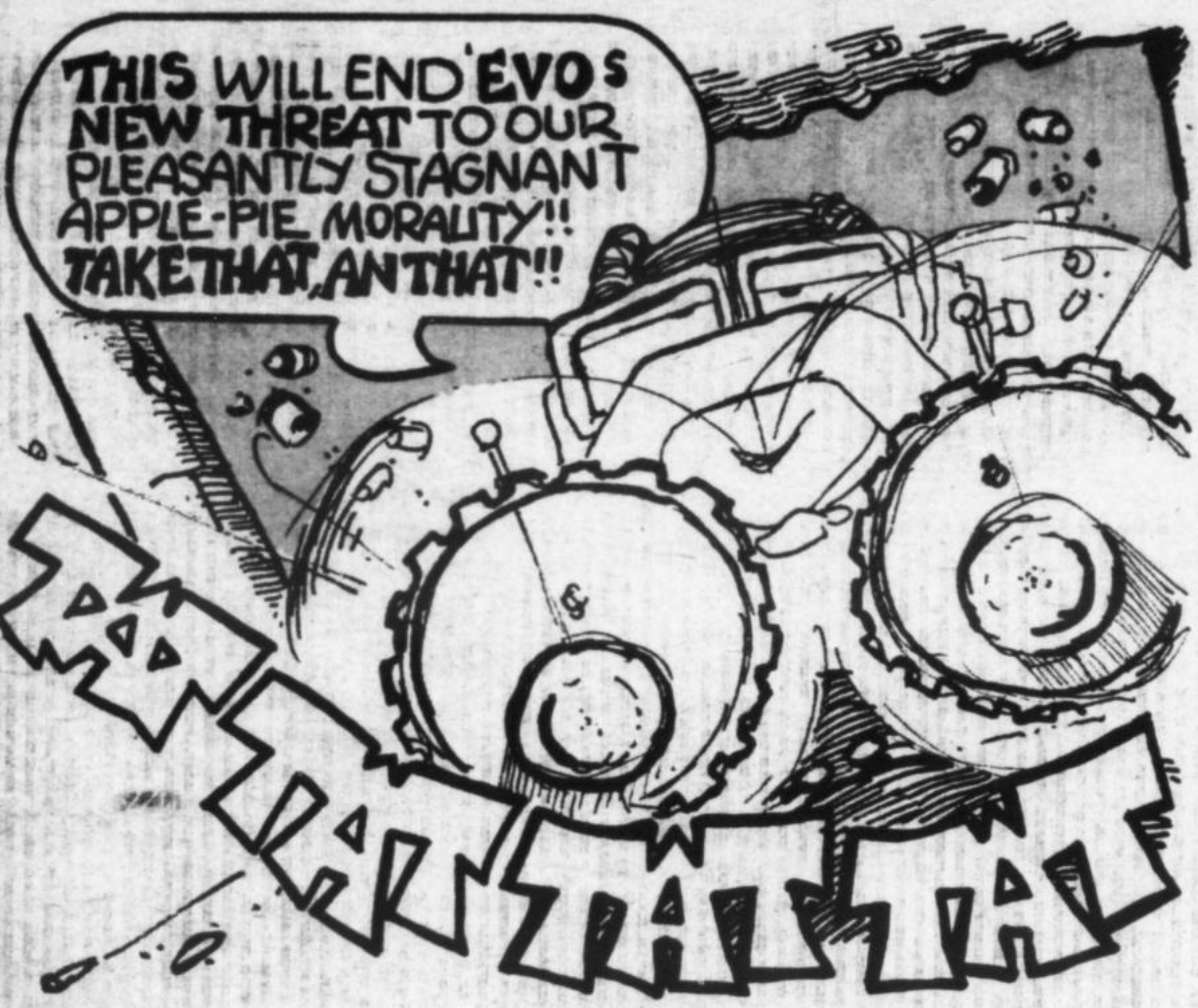

FUCKING ALL OVER!

Dear EVO:

Don Katzman's article, "Apple Pie," was gratefully received. It laid out the viewpoints in a way that can be discussed.

What has bothered me about the New Left is that its objectives and processes all seem to echo and reinforce the military-industrial establishment. Take Katzman's insistence on wiping out states' rights and centralizing power. That's what Napoleon did. Has anyone ever heard a single holding company support states' rights? Isn't centralized power the whole principle of corporate structure? Can you name one mass magazine that hasn't printed articles supporting centralized power? When every print-shop from the New York Times to the industrial house-organs are loudly calling for centralization of power, why should the effort require the cooperation of the underground?

It was also interesting to read Katzman's attribution of the Constitution to Hamilton and Madison. Like the establishment, he ignores Jefferson and Franklin, and never heard of the Iroquois. Permit me to quote Franklin:

"It would be a strange thing if Six Nations of ignorant savages should be capable of forming a scheme (the Great Law of Deganawida) for such a union (the Iroquois Federation), and be able to execute it in such a manner as that it has subsisted ages and appears indissoluble; and yet that a like union should be impracticable for ten or a dozen English colonies to whom it is more necessary and must be more advantageous, and who cannot be supposed to want an equal understanding of their interests."

Katzman blames states' rights for massive Black immigration to northern urban centers. Everybody who doesn't live in Manhattan knows that the loss of work in the south, and the extirpation of the little farmers, was the result of the farm programs dreamed up by centralized power, and the "scientists" who ran it. The programs greatly enriched the big farmers and put the small ones off the land. After the fact, the liberal apologists informed us that "the small farm was inefficient," anyway. Somehow, the spectacle of millions of uprooted, dishonored black Americans milling around in urban centers, on the dole (call it a welfare wage, if you speak establishment), detested by other Americans whose roots in this country and culture are not a fraction as deep, seems infinitely more inefficient to me than a lot of good small farmers, at home in their own country.

The trouble with scientists is that their understanding is not human, but theoretical. That's the problem of nuclear warheads, mutated germs, nerve gases, "humane" mace, pesticides, dams, jetports, etc. Human beings are organic creatures who go bad and mad when treated like equations. And what makes Katzman think that scientists are somehow more virtuous than politicians? He should attend the hearings on any public works project. There he could hear the scientific whores hired by industry to plead their cases and contradict the scientists who speak for conservation. He could hear the scientists bureaucrats who always seem to find the industrial scientists more scientific than the scientists who have nothing to gain.

Katzman follows the establishment line that states' rights somehow hurt the urban areas. Before, it was all those "rotten burroughs" that had to be reapportioned that hurt the urban areas. Is he saying that hurt the urban areas. Is he saying that the virtual disfranchisement of rural America didn't save the cities, after all?

The real solution for the cities was discussed. Turn them into city-states and give them control of their own rich tax resources. But nobody liked that idea, because, unlike the reapportionment decision, it didn't give the holding companies urban-based power to take over all the watersheds, valleys, airsheds and game reserves of the rural areas. If the urban centers haven't been able to realize HEW and HUD funds, it's because it's all up here, at the service of the real estate affiliates, who are subdividing and urban-renewing farmlands and forests. Meanwhile, the mountaineers are driven out, condemned by the federal government anxious to provide "recreation and green acres" for urban masses whose cities continue to collapse.

Considering the results of reapportionment, the prospect of abolishing states' rights (what's left of them) can only mean the total disinheritance of the American people. I guess that since the establishment already has a monopoly on energy, food and produc-

tion, the only thing left for them to seize is all the land.

To get to Katzman's suggestions:

1 — He says to abolish states' rights, since they're merely "an administrative branch of the federal government." That's what's happened to them and that's what's wrong! Listen to the Blacks. "Community control" is what they want. Tribe rights, Iroquois style. What the hell good are Civil Rights if they don't give your environment? States' rights protect community rights, from federal dictatorship. Katzman wants to reform the separate states (nations) into departments of a single state, Napoleonic style. That's pure militarism, orders from on high. It's the total reversal of power mounting up from the Sovereign People. Instead of curing our disease, we have decided to make it permanent and call it "health."

2 — Abandon the seniority rule. There's no unmixed good and that's a fact, but you can get a pretty pure precipitate of evil, if you try. For every old puke you cut down, there'd be a Fulbright lost — and McCarthy notwithstanding, there'd have been no Vietnam issue without Fulbright. Hate for seniority is hate for the constituencies that keep returning those men; it's the establishment's hate for the people. The real problem is with a newspaper business that has become nothing but a propaganda mill for the puppets of the power structure. When last I heard, the gang had a bill in the Senate to exempt newspapers from the anti-monopoly laws.

3 — A separate authority . . . Godammit, is the New Left for or against authority? It's authority that's bad. Authority is the end of "government of laws and not men." The fact that the laws are broken everywhere and iniquity reigns is the real crime wave, confined to the upper levels. This is the plan that turns the criminals into kings.

4 — The federal government will use the corporate entities — or will the corporate entities use the federal government? Not that they haven't been doing so for the past forty years. We have a permanent depression on the bottom of our economy and a permanent affluence on the top. The only way to mix them up again and restore social mobility is to BREAK UP THE CORPORATIONS. Everyone smashed back to little ones will be create lots of jobs and opportunities, reduce the tremendous pressure on Congress, calm the lusts for empire, shorten the tentacles that are strangling us all. If that isn't done, then collapse, revolution and breaking up of the nation into little nations will have to come, by all known laws of physics, biology and American sociology.

And this is a "modern" society! Absolute bureaucracy under monarchic control is as old as Egypt, as defunct as Mandarin China, as untenable as Nazi Germany. How is it that a New Left can so resemble the im memorial Old Right?

I think it's time for the New Left to quit patronizing the Blacks and listen to them. The Blacks are the last of the non-red Iroquois. They have in their bones memories of the ancient values of this land that first and second generation Americans were never permitted to learn. Maybe they're so smart because they're born of "virgins," like Deganawida and Jesus. The oedipalized masses seem to come out of cocks' eggs. Maybe they are smart because few of them have been through the castration rite of an establishment education.

Since you support the entire program of the establishment, you may wonder why they persecute you. I think you must be infringing their patents. They come first on hallucinogens (look at the TV ads, read the commercial press, study the GNP, listen to the stock market returns). They've been printing obscenities for years — political obscenities like "power," "control," "obedience," rule and reign," "status." They also like free sex and they've been fucking Liberty and Justice all over the place, for fun games. You peasants aren't allowed to mimic the ways of the great — not even symbolically. LAW AND ORDER DEPT: THE CASE OF SELECTIVE SERVICE VS. ANTONIO JOHN FARGAS

When Antonio Fargas was 13 he tried out for the lead in Shirley Clark's film on Harlem street life, *THE COOL WORLD*. Impressed with the young actor, Miss Clark offered him a screen test, but then turned him down. "I lost that part," Fargas recalls, "Because the lead was a tough guy, a street-soldier, and I just couldn't play that kind of role. You see, I didn't grow up Uptown so I never was much of a fighter. My mother always told me that good people weren't violent and that just all came through on the screen test." Not wishing to waste what was an obvious talent, Miss Clark did cast Fargas in a smaller featured role. Today Antonio Fargas is one of the most important young Black actors working on the stage. He plays the Juju Man, an 85 year old soothsayer, in the Broadway hit, *THE GREAT WHITE HOPE*.

What Shirley Clark perceived in Fargas, a non-violent gentle spirit, is exactly what New York's Local Draft Board #5 missed! In 1966, Tony Fargas received a notice to report for induction into the U.S. Armed Forces. Some people fall apart when they receive their "greetings." Others resign themselves to two unpleasant years in green with Uncle Sam. But for Tony the receipt of a draft notice resulted in hours of deep soul-searching. Finally, he came to the conclusion that he was a conscientious objector and that indeed he had been one all his life. "I knew that I couldn't kill," he explains. "My mother had brought up my 10 sisters and brothers to be non-violent people — only she never used the words 'conscientious objector.' I knew what I was, only I never knew the word for the things I believed." An application to the draft board for C. O. status and a hearing four days before induction proved fruitless. The hostile board fired one question after another at Tony, refused to hear a witness testify to his sincerity, and hastily ordered him to report for induction as scheduled. Tony

reported to Whitehall Street determined to prove his sincerity by not taking that famous step forward. A sergeant at the induction center attempted to induce him to change his mind by offering him a deal: "He said that he'd fix it so that I wouldn't have to kill. You know, he told me I'd be sent to a non-combatant unit. But I knew he was jiving. I just couldn't let them put me in a situation where I might have to commit murder." Unswayed by military promises, Fargas refused induction into the U.S. Army.

Last December the case of the United States of America vs. Antonio John Fargas, defendant, came to court. Tony's lawyer, civil liberties attorney Victor Rabinowitz, had built his whole case on the question of Fargas' beliefs crystallizing upon the receipt of his draft notice. A U.S. District Judge had ruled in an earlier case, *U.S. vs. Gearey*, that a man could legitimately reach the conclusion that he was a C.O. after he received an order to report for induction. According to the *Gearey* decision, the receipt of the induction notice can be the triggering mechanism which resulted in the final crystallization of conscientious objection to killing. Rabinowitz hoped to prove that this was exactly the situation with Antonio. Fargas' case was further buttressed by a rather glib memo in his Selective Service file, which denied his request for C.O. status. This memo, dated June 9, 1966, signed by draft board member W.A. Tucker, made no reference to Fargas' beliefs crystallizing. It simply dismissed Tony as insincere and ordered him to report for induction:

"Said he had been a C.O. all his life. Although did not mention this in Questionnaire dated 8-24-64. Form #150 received, interviewed at length. No consideration to C.O. Registration report for induction as scheduled."

Several minutes before the trial began, Rabinowitz was handed a copy of the U.S. District Attorney's brief. (This is usual courtroom procedure). Glancing through the document, Rabinowitz noticed reference to a Selective Service memo dated June 9, 1966, but completely different from the

memo that the defense had on hand. (It should be noted that Rabinowitz had possession of Tony Fargas' complete S.S. file). Suspicion led the defense attorney to ask the U.S. DA for his copy of the June 9th memo. The memo was produced and interestingly enough, it was very different from what had been originally placed in Fargas' file:

"Said he had been a Conscientious Objector all his life, though failed to indicate prior to issuance of induction order. There has been no change in registrants status resulting from CIRCUMSTANCES OVER WHICH THE REGISTRANT HAD NO CONTROL SINCE ISSUANCE OF INDUCTION ORDER. LATENESS INDICATES INSINCERITY."

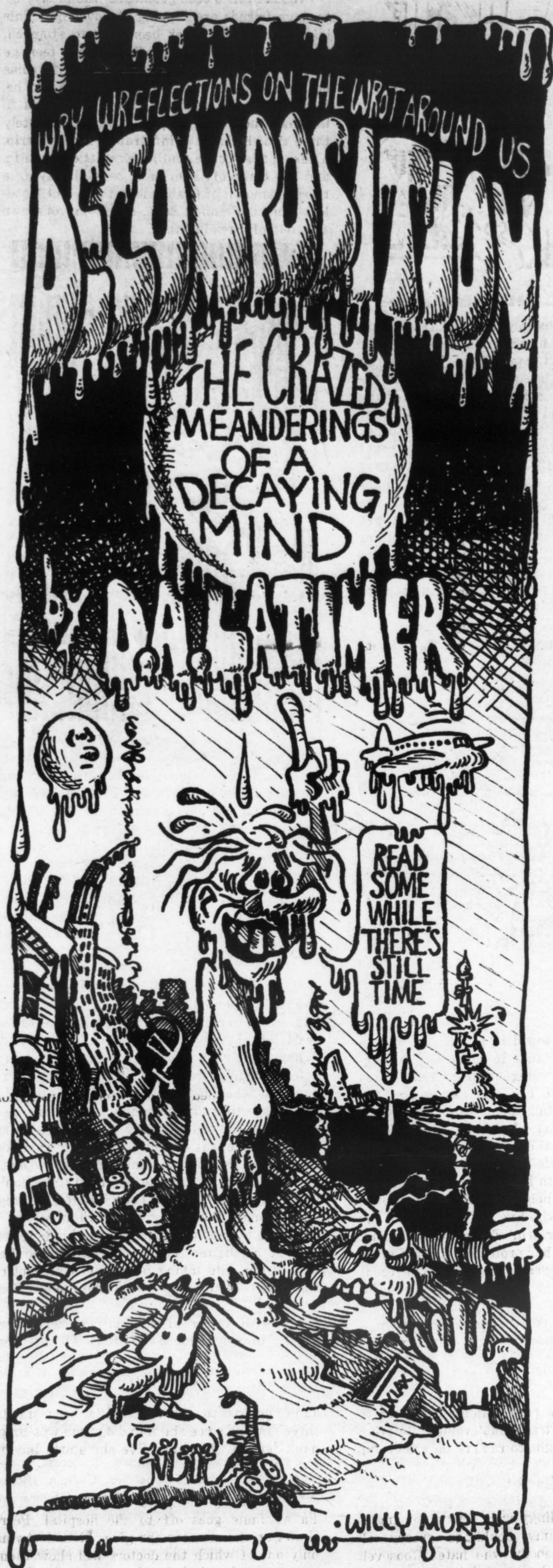
An examination of the D.A.'s copy of Tony Fargas' Selective Service file proved that the prosecutor had only one memo dated June 9th, this new one. But what was even more revealing was that this second memo took into account the working of the *Gearey* decision, which was handed down some four months after June 9, 1966! (See italics).

An embarrassed D. A. tried to bury the whole matter by moving to dismiss the case. But Rabinowitz refused to cooperate with any whitewash. Instead he demanded a complete investigation to what appeared like a clear case of governmental fraud. Judge Frederick Van Pelt Bryan agreed that the situation was a bit peculiar and ordered U.S. Assistant District Attorney Thomas J. Fitzpatrick to investigate this little legal error.

What Fitzpatrick discovered was highly enlightening and should concern every young man who has dealings with Selective Service. It seems that a legal officer of Selective Service, Captain Thomas Maher, called a member of the local board and asked him to rewrite the original June 9th memo. A new memo, he said, that would be more clear and take into account the language of *Gearey*, was needed.

The board member of course, complied by inserting a new memo in Fargas' file and by removing

Golly gee, comixfans, it's sure nice to have you bac this week! True, a New York newsstand organization summarily refused to carry that particular issue of EVO, but this is all right, since our absence at one stand only augments our sales on the next corner—'Hey, what's in EVO this week makes it dirtier than *Absolutely True War Stories For Men Only Illustrated Color Magazine*?' And when you get right down to it, there really isn't anything in EVO that can match for sheer scatology the best Daily News lead stories, the ones that enumerate in precise gory detail the latest gross malfunctions of General Eisenhower's body. Let's see them win **this** one for Ike . . .

And that's what this article's all about, the Daily News and the comics thereof. There shouldn't be any reason to write about the Daily News comics, because everybody should be familiar with them; but like Claudia Dreifus (who was horribly offended by R. Crumb last week, and understandably so) complains, people today have lost their sense of humour. Like, hardly anybody I know reads the News any more because it pisses them off. They can't tolerate it. This I think is profoundly regrettable: the News is a paragon of excellence in its own field—exploitative sensation—and should be enjoyed as such. Every issue is an invaluable textbook in journalistic propaganda, how to sell your message to the people—and since it is undeniably The People who read the News, this paper offers a daily index to their passions, myths, pretensions and predilections. The News is a wildly human paper, and anybody who enjoys and loves human beings is passing up something really meaningful and rewarding if he passes up the News.

The problem with all these people who put down the News is really quite simple—they mistake the real message that the News is selling the people. It's not primarily selling Right-wing kill-em-all gas-the-bastards back-to-crewcuts propaganda, no, what it's selling is ads. I haven't counted the inches of ad space in either paper, but I think the News prints more ads every day than the Voice prints every week, which is phenomenal. And what's the best posture to assume when selling ads to the people? Why, a good solid military posture, a mother-loving commie-hating deodorated toothpasted lawanorder posture, one the naturally slobbish, apathetic, easily panicked people can look up to and feel protected by. You'd buy a used car, even one with defective brakes, from a man who wants to kill all the commies, wouldn't you? Sure you would, and that's where the News is at. Nobody who has the brains to **spell it right: Atrocity, not Atrosity** really wants to H-Bomb Haiphong, kill all the commies, and gas the lazy bastards on welfare and SEEK scholarships: no, I'm convinced the people that do the Daily News thing are just manufacturing a good solid posture from which to peddle their advertising pages. If the people by some unnatural quirk get really fired up by the News editorials and go on a super-fascist trip as a result, then hell, that's just tough tittie for everybody, including the Daily News editorial hacks. With this in mind, the News becomes a very amusing paper indeed.

But the finest and most typical manifestation of the propaganda line by which the News supports its advertising is provided by the fanatics who actually appear to believe this horseshit, that is, the cartoonists. The News carries twenty comic strips every day and on Sunday, and all its cartoonists, to a greater or lesser extent, adhere to the line set on the editorial pages: that is, they uphold the little people, decry incursions upon middleclass security from any quarter, cast contempt on all things sophisticated or intellectual, and call overtly or implicitly for a return to the comatose values of the Lawrence Welk President Eisenhower fabulous fifties era. The comic strip is an exclusively American phenomenon—if anything can be said for this country, it has evolved the Comic Strip into an art comparable to the epics of Homer, Snurrleson, the Minnesingers and the Bhagavad-Gita—and anybody curious about what Americans are up to, where their heads are at, should certainly study the comics in the Daily News. But not at the expense of simple enjoyment.

Enough fucking introduction! On. Dick Tracy. Dick Tracy operates out of Chicago, with frequent trips to the Moon, as elaborated by artist Chester Gould. This strip's been going since 1931, which is getting to be quite a stretch, and in the last few years Gould has turned it into something rather bizzare. Oh, it's always been pretty wierd, what with its grotesque villians (Noface, Anyface, Flyface) and its incredible cast of supporting characters (B. O. Plenty, Sparkle Plenty, all that crew)—but since around 1964 this Gould has gotten off into some exceptionally preposterous places.

Yes, 1964 or thereabouts . . . Al Capp started going apeshit around then, too, but we'll get to Capp later. It was in '64, I believe, that Diet Smith, the technological genius of the Tracy strip, solved the riddle of Magnetism, invented the air car and the space coupe, discovered the Moon and claimed it for America, and married off Moon Maid to Junior, Tracy's son. Since then, this whole Moon trip has informed the entire Tracy gestalt with an atmosphere of truly paranoid fantasy. Someday somebody'll fill

up a whole PhD thesis in abnormal psychology on the archtypal paranoia syndromes evident in Dick Tracy's Moon sequences.

But that's all pretty far out, so before we get into the Moon at a Gould, let's dig the way Dick Tracy operates when he's on Earth. A quick resume shows that since 1964 Tracy's villains have been mostly young and hip, or what passes for hip after Chester Gould interprets it. All of '65, well into '66, he was fighting an assortment of criminals that centered around a chick called Ugly Christine, who was a prize: she wore a black miniskirt, hell, a micro-skirt, this Ugly Christine, and you never saw her face above her nose because her ratty black hair hung down to her mouth, with the little flies buzzing through it all the time. Dig it, hardly any chicks were wearing real minis then, people were still bitching because hemlines had gone with Jackie Kennedy up above the Patella. But Ugly Christine wore a mini, and Gould had all kinds of fun with that mini. For over a year, Dick Tracy was the sexiest strip on the stands, sexier even than Lil' Abner. Poor Ugly Christine, he had her fighting with other chicks, with men, he had her tied in a very strenuous and uncomfortable posture to a chair for nearly a month — and in a sort of super-climax, when she fell to her death from Tracy's magnetic air car (after a horrible bloody tooth-breaking fistfight with Tracy) there were a half-dozen or so panels that showed her **panties**, little tight red panties, before she plummeted into a black smokestack, which erupted in a glorious cloud of smoke as a result. I have this page around somewhere still, it turns me on more all the notebooks of R. Crumb — which shows you how futile the obscenity laws are.

Parenthetically, one of the crooks that clustered around Ugly Christine was an appealing little fellow who got foully murdered, and whose name I regrettably forget — but he carried on his shoulder a Siamese cat, something I never saw A.J. Weberman take into account.

This is the way Dick Tracy relates to his enemies, but it has to be explained in the way Chester Gould looks at crime and criminals. The whole Ugly Christine trip was unmistakably of a sexual, sadistic, fetishistic nature, but it was entirely legit because Ugly Christine was a crook and this is what crooks have coming to them. For some people, understand, crime itself is a fetish: a crime fetishist can get the same perverted thrill out of a criminal investigation ('Ah, a lipsticked cigarette! The criminal, gentleman, was a woman!') as a silk fetishist gets out of going through his dowager aunt's beside bureau drawers. The primitive cycle of transgression, guilt, and retribution is The Myth for these people, the epic that stirs them from gonads to superego: I don't swing that way myself, but Chester Gould has shown me how it works.

Now, the Ugly Christine episode was a pretty extreme instance of this fetishism. Usually Tracy's arch-enemies are men, doomed men against whom the deck is so inexorably stacked that they'd clearly do better to turn themselves in voluntarily to the feds than face Tracy's wrath, which generally brings about their death in a variety of disagreeable fashions. But they persist in their dastardly mechanations, generally with a palpable aura of doom and guilt hanging about them. The whole thing is so sick . . .

The Moon. It has been said that Gould's panels are more like diagrams than true compositions, and when he gets Tracy off to the Moon this technique is demonstrated at its best. Rather than panels of action with a recognisable background and foreground, on the Moon Chester Gould gives us diagrams: great longshots of the curvature of the moon's surface with huge gaping rents in it pouring steam from the warm jungles down below. Temperature 83°f., a little box hanging in midair tells us. You see Tracy and Diet Smith flying around in their magnetic air cars, and a box below it urgently declares: "The Nation That Controls Magnetism Will Control The Universe". (One nation controlling the Universe?!? In hands other than Gould's,



this would be impossibly rich satire — but Gould means it, for him there's no reason why one nation shouldn't control the Universe as long as that nation is America. Diet Smith Industries mines tons and tons of gold out of the moon with lasars and gives it to America, shuddering the while at the prospect of any other nation getting all that gold: why, they could take over the world.) With magnetism, Tracy can get to the Moon from Chicago in 57 minutes: there is much scoffing in this strip at the poor primitives who use rocket power to get around, and Smith keeps emergency shelters here and there about the Moon with signs that say "Welcome stranded rocket passengers". All this and magnetism too: "A moon landing without mobility is suicide," a caption sternly, if obscurely, warns us. Another says, "If you ain't moonminded, you ain't." Too much, and getting wilder all the time.



There's a whole world in Gould, and I pass on with great reluctance to Little Orphan Annie. This has been going on since 1924, when Harold Grey created her, and has become the comic strip people talk about when they want to make funny jokes about the Right Wing. Little Annie, with the round empty eyes and the invulnerable little red dress, runs about all over the country with her dog Sandy ("ARF!") helping and being helped by the little people, the jes' plain folk who live at the mercy of the crooks and the interferin' Federal Government. Oliver Warbucks is her protector, the self-made billionaire, the American Onassis, who in recent years has become the most powerful single individual on the face of the Earth. And this Right-wing megalomania is getting me down, a column on Gould was enough: the craziness springs from the helplessness the Right feels when it discovers its own impotence to kill the commies, gas the welfare loafers, and elect anything better than a poorly animated golem to lead the return to traditional values. Before I go on, though, I ought to remark on something peculiar about Grey's strip, which is his architecture: no where else will you find WPA architecture so lovingly rendered, great stretches of bare solemn dingy wall, four right angles to each wall, crummy mouldings, dreary colours . . . For somebody who hates Roosevelt with such passion, Grey certainly captures the feeling of thirties architecture.

Brenda Starr's been getting so wild lately, my teenage friends are flipping out over her. This is one strip I've never been able to stomach, the very style turns me off — like a teenage girl's idea of a fashion sketch, Brenda Starr has no flesh, just the lines where flesh should be. I certainly can't follow it, there are limits to the insipitude even I'll put up with. But lately these two chicks have infiltrated into her strip, a sexy little blonde and a sexy little brunette, and the three of them have been displaying a terrible amount of flesh among them. But bloodless women I cannot take, so go on your own trip out of Brenda Starr.



Winnie Winkle is a funny strip. The whole Winkle family is a study in congenital incompetence: there's Winnie, her brother Perry and his wife Janie, her twin kids Billie and Wendy, and they all live together with her Ma and Pa. This strip has gone through many interesting changes since its inception in 1920. At first it was a funny domestic comedy, Pa was a little man with a red nose, a real fall guy, and Winnie was a flapper. Then her brother Perry Winkle emerged as a great hero, around the thirties and forties. And now, lately, they've all clustered together in one little plot of frightened middleclass incompetence, neurosis, and fear.

It's a cool strip to follow for laughs, if you like really ghoulish laughs. Dig it, Janie Winkle had twins herself last winter, and the ordeal nearly killed everyone in the strip. Perry Winkle is now a big shot in some corporation, and just before Janie's pregnancy was announced his boss had scheduled a trip around the world for him, inspecting "installments" in various desolate areas. He couldn't very well call it off just because Janie was expecting, but she was having fits at the idea of him going off without her. Cool? There was the possibility she could tag along, but it was a poor idea for a pregnant woman. But Perry the great hero has a backbone of snot when it comes to his wife, so, against his better judgement, he allowed her to talk him into taking her along. Every place they went — the North Pole, the Sahara Desert, the rain forests of Brazil — she shit her pants with terror of the natives, who were usually brawny coloured WASPS. All this time the folks back home are getting sick wondering about her. At length, after a particularly severe trauma complete with hallucinations, Janie agrees to fly home. It's been maybe three months since she found out she was pregnant, but on Christmas Eve she starts having her baby. Perry's stranded somewhere by an earthquake, they don't know where he is. "What a horrible way to spend Christmas," whines Pa as Janie goes off to the hospital. Perry shows up the moment she gives birth to twins, only one of which the doctors will show them, since the other is being kept in an incubator. The little one has a birth defect. Guess why.

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Janie goes into a catatonic stupor, and they have to hire a shrink (his first name is Virgil) to pull her out of it. The shrink gets hot pants for Winnie, and here we go again.



One rather interesting aspect of this strip is the progressive militarization of Billie, Winnie's son, in the last year or so. Billie's just a high school kid, but lately his blue-eyed blonde head has been shaved nearly to the bone, leaving only a few wire-bristle hairs at the top of his head, and the sport coat and tie he wears everywhere, even lounging around the house, have become tighter and stiffer with every student riot. For the youthful frivolity of the militant few, the decent many like Billy Winkle needs must suffer.

Al Capp is a difficult study, and we're not going to have room here to do him justice. At one point he was the best damn American satirist alive; now Philip Roth has that distinction, which shows you where American satire has got to. Where Al Capp has got to is even more distressing. I'll go into his strip some other time, when he does something really pertinent and offensive. Right now, an anecdote will have to do: last month Vaughn Bode attended a meeting at the Americana of the National Cartoonist Association members, who were trying to woo him into syndicating his incandescence nationally. Al Katzman went with him, and during the proceedings Katzman and Capp traded epithets — "You're obscene!" "You're more obscene than I am!" — and all was a bloody shambles. But afterwards, Capp approached Bode and said this: "You're Bode? I'm a fan of yours." Yow, Sandy! To be told by Al Capp that you're doing good stuff is still akin to being told by Che Guevara that you're making good Revolution.

The rest of the News comics are of varying interest. At the very nadir of boredom is something called Louie, of which the best that can be said is that its episodic development — problem, crisis, and resolution — is often as artful as Bushmiller's Nancy. At the peak of interest is Leonard Starr's On Stage, the adventures of actress Mary Perkins. In his own way, Starr is an even better artist than Harold Foster: this strip lays the sixties down in textures, colours, noises, smells, architecture, fashions, faces . . . And the psychology of the characters, while not too damn profound, is extremely consistent and provocative. Also in the News is Moon Mullins, which maintains an amusing portrayal of lowerclass boardinghouse existence nearly on a par with Andy Capp. Then there's Pottsy, the Irish cop, who enjoys an endearing love-hate relationship with his superiors and the mildly antisocial malefactors he encounters. Kerry Drake is also a fairly loveable strip — Alfred Andriola, who used to do Charlie Chan, executes a lovely form of draughtmanship and often surprises one by being halfway sympathetic to hippies, petty crooks, runaway girls and whatnot. A Chester Gould he is not. And finally there's Dondi, which while I cannot say it is interesting at least had a charming portrait of Ultra Violet (not the race horse, the superstarlet) in its Sunday and Monday pages a few months back.

PILLS, POT & HEAVY PETTING

A couple years ago it was all the rage to read Konrad Lorenz and Robert Ardrey and get the straight poop on territorial instincts in animals and man, and prate about it in tones of profoundest despair at the weekly cocktail party. One of the more amusing ideas Ardrey came up with was the thesis that the entire history of humankind was inescapably informed by weapons technology: that is, no sooner did *Pitheanthropocus Erectus* (or was it *Australopithecus Zaksmundtsus*) notice he could lift with ease the jawbone of an arse than he was off murdering innocent hyenas and softshell crabs. Ork! The Killer Ape! From these ignoble beginnings *Homo Neanderthalensis*, the Cro Magnon sorts, and *Homo* (you should pardon the expression) *Sapiens* progressed through slingshot, blunderbuss, torpedo, and stiletto to the Bomb, which to Ardrey is the veritable Crown of Creation and leaves nothing for Man to do but either blow himself away or die like the Tasmanians out of faggoty frustration. Sounds dismal, don't it? Don't be faked out, it's really very lovely, it tickles the mind of the intellectual, gives him something to moan about intellectually. It's too pretty to be true.

Actually, the bona fide true scoop on this question is that the entire history of humankind is informed by frogs. The opposable thumb evolved out of primeval man's wristbone solely and expressly for use in grasping frogs, which are very squamous and shy. The history of civilization can be traced by charting the invention of devices to torture frogs. But now the end is near, because B. Pyle of St. Regis Falls, New York — my own back yard — has developed the very last word in frog-gigging sophistication. Pyle writes:

I have frogged around with frogs since I can remember. One thing you never run out of — frogs. I just want you to know what I discovered a few years ago. I have told different people about it and I honestly think I invented this one.

Ork! We're under arrest again! Barely a week after this virtuous, crusading, rightward-tending weekly fact sheet was clobbered in Jersey and Southern California, we were *again* fondled by the long arm of the law in Ballston Spa, New York. EVO's editors and readers have consequently become so exceedingly paranoid about this — *this organized wave of political repression!* — that they are liable to fall into flashback syndrome if the air isn't cleared a bit. Accordingly, with an eye toward ventilating this latest paranoia, allow me to quote, with commentary, from the *Saratogan*, Ballston Spa's rightward-tending daily paper. Carrying on its cover a picture of the local smut peddler being led away from his nasty den in chains, the story went like this:



Ballston Man Arrested On Smut Book Charge

BALLSTON SPA—Paul Gillingham, 26, of McGinn's Trailer Court, Rt—, Ballston Spa, operator of the Crystal Mansion on Rt 50, north of here, was released on \$500 bail Tuesday after being charged with *possessio with intent of selling obscene literature*. County deputy sheriffs armed with a search warrant swooped down in two cars about 4 p.m. and conducted a 30-minute search of the premises. Several items were removed, including copies of an 'underground newspaper'.

Actually, the deputy sheriffs were armed with guns. Deputy sheriffs *are*, you know, it's their thing. The two warrants with which they supplemented these firearms were for the search of Gillingham's head shop/boutique (the only one in Ballston Spa) and for the arrest of Gillingham. Swoop down on his premises they did, they just maneuvered the hell out of his place: disregarding all danger to their persons these intrepid officers charged in and ripped the shit out of Gillingham's store. Apparently they thought there might be clandestine copies of *Lucky Pierre* hidden in the walls and ceiling, because they just *destroyed* the place, like I said. Then, clapping the cuffs on Gillingham, they dragged him off to the pokey. The 'underground newspaper' they took with them was EVO — and also two naughty posters, 'Yab-Yum' and 'Togetherness'.

Gillingham was charged with *possession with intent of selling obscene literature* and appeared in Milton Justice Court and was released in \$500 bail pending a hearing Feb. 24 at 1 p.m. About an hour after the incident the store was again reopened for business. A source indicated the store had been under surveillance for several months and raiding officer's 'apparently did not find what they were looking for'. There was no indication what they were looking for.

Don't wrack your brain wondering about it: they were looking for dope. Among the inventory of the Crystal Mansion there are various dope paraphernalia like Zig-Zag papers and rollers, and in the inimitable words of Louis Minsky, "Where there's smoke, there's salmon." The intrepid officers knew damn well there weren't no copies of *Lucky Pierre* or *What Jimmy Saw (at the Picnic)* concealed in the insulation, they were looking for psychedelic narcotics. Unhappily, as the source indicated, Gillingham was clean — so the long arm of the law had to make do with our Concrete Poetry extravaganza, which embarrassingly was the cleanest issue we have published in many a month. If they'd swooped down a week before they would have got Gross' titillating 'Fucking Through The Ages' to masturbate over; a week later they'd have got Crumb's childmolesting fantasy. As it was they got concrete poetry, which is *coitus interruptus* to the Nth degree.

Sheriff's Investigator James Bowen said the arrest and search was made because of a large number of complaints which has been received about

SOVIET ATTACKS CHINA, PEKING ASSERTS PUBLICALLY

HONG KONG (EVO) — The People's Republic of China reported this week that the Soviet Union's border guards along the Ussuri river in Manchuria attacked and killed or wounded Liberation Army troops.

(Moscow, meanwhile, charged that it was the Chinese who attacked across the frozen river in the area of Chentapao whose ownership is disputed. The Tass report said there were casualties but did not say on which side or how many).

In a rare departure from past incidents, Peking Radio carried a report of the fight and that Peking sent a stiff note to the Russians. The Chinese also said that they rejected a Soviet protest over the affair.

Peking recently has stepped up its propaganda assaults on the Soviet and in the last issue of Peking Review, the Maoist theoretical journal, it devoted more than two pages to the "crimes" of the "revisionist clique" now in power in Moscow.

While analysis in Moscow offered the opinion that the Russians have attempted to shift world attention away from the impending crisis in Berlin by swiftly and publicly calling attention to the Ussuri river affair which they say the Chinese started, it is thought by observers here on the edge of China that Peking might have been acting to attract the attention of the Arab world by showing up the Russians. Thus China publically talked of the fight in Manchuria.

The reasoning goes something like this:

The Russians have been winning friends and influencing world opinion by its moves in the Mideast. Its proposals for a big power settlement has already won tacit if not overt acceptance in several Western capitals as well as in the Arab world.

France, picking up the Soviet ball, carried the game further by proposing that it, the Soviet Union, Britain and the United States hold four-power talks at the United Nations on the Arab-Israeli situation. A preliminary meeting under this proposal was held last Feb. 5 with no tangible results. A second meeting apparently was held later.

But the United States, meanwhile, reasserted its position by inviting the Russians to bi-lateral talks which were held in Washington late last month. But since the second meeting, nothing public has been revealed from the talks. But there was one statement made by President Nixon while on his European tour.

The President mentioned that no accommodations could be made on the German issue until the Russians agreed to some political concession in the Mideast.

Meanwhile, the Russians have been actively calling on the Arab leaders to accept its five-point Mideast plan which calls for the withdrawal of Israeli troops but also an end to the state of belligerency.

The Chinese call the Soviet plan a fraud because it denies the Palestinian peoples the right "to wage their just struggle."

"In its joint maneuvers with US imperialism to push through the plot of a political solution of the Middle East question," Peking said, "the Soviet revisionist renegade clique has dished up a notorious five-point plan. The gist of it was made public in a signed article of the Soviet revisionist paper

Pravda on January 25 . . . it is not difficult to see that this plan is a big betrayal of the Arab people's interests.

"It is particularly noteworthy that the Soviet revisionist formula does not mention a single word about the rights of the Palestinian people. Instead it proposes in ambiguous terms "a just settlement of the refugee problem."

Observers here, taking into account the Chinese position on the Mideast, namely advocacy of the continuation of the fighting until the Arabs obtain victory, it is believed that the Ussuri river battle was to be dramatic proof that the Chinese dare to struggle, dare to win (to take Mao's words) against the Russians, that is, all reactionaries.

The Chinese clash, then, is being seen as an implicit encouragement to the Palestinian leadership. It may also be aimed at supporting last week's Syrian coup by military forces which want close ties with the ruling Baathist regime in Iraq. The Baghdad government offers full support to the Arab commandos.

So far there is no indication that China is prepared to aid materially in the Palestinian struggle, and so far Palestinians have not been able to seriously damage the Israelis.

But the pressures are obviously growing. President Nasser last weekend warned that a fourth war looms unless the Israelis quit the occupied territories.

There is suspicion, too, that the death of the Israeli premier, Levi Eshkol, and the power struggle now going on in Tel Aviv, may have been a motivating factor in the complicated political situation. The Israelis appear to be fully aware of the danger of allowing their political vacuum to remain unfilled for long.

It is thought that the Arabs wish to move quickly if the Jews give any hint of disarray because of the political fight between Allon and Dayan. But so far, the Israelis remain in control of the situation at home.

No firm judgements can be made at this time as to whether the Sino-Soviet clash will evolve into a more violent situation. But the Russians seem to be prepared to defend the strip of Far East territory acquired in the time of the Czars. The logistical problems involved in supporting forces in the Far East are enormous, thus giving the Chinese an advantage right at the start. And China does have nuclear potential on its Western frontier with the Russians.

Another aspect of the situation is the relatively sudden reassertion of China in world affairs after the long upheaval of the Cultural Revolution.

First the Chinese last November called for a meeting with the United States in Warsaw on Feb. 20 to discuss the possibilities of peaceful co-existence under the terms of the 1955 Bandung Conference of Third World nations.

But on Feb. 19, the Chinese cancelled the talks on the grounds that the United States had "incited Liao Hoshut to betray his country." Liao was the charge d'affaires for the Peking legation to the Netherlands. He is now in the United States where he apparently is seeking political asylum.

But the fact that the Chinese sought talks with America is in itself interesting. The Chinese also are talking trade with the Yugoslavs who as revisionist are anybody in the East bloc. And now the Ussuri river affair and the attention being given to exploiting the incident publically.

Another factor is the world Communist congress which the Soviet seems to finally have put on the road. Thwarted on at least two other occasions the Moscow party has been struggling toward a world meeting in the hopes of retaining its dominant position, or at least the drumming out of the Chinese.

But if China, discredited in much of the red world during the Cultural Revolution, comes back on the scene in a power position, the Russian plans are likely to go awry. Time is the key factor here.

This all points to what one Sino-logist here called the reassertion of the professionals in the Peking foreign ministry. China, it is thought, is embarking once again on an internationalist trip.

OFFSHORE EXPLORATION SCHEDULED BY JAKARTA

UNITED NATIONS, N.Y. (EVO) — The Indonesian government is soon to embark on a \$2.3 million project to ferret out offshore alluvial tinore from the sea bed.

The exploration will be jointly funded by the government and the United Nations Development Program on almost a fifty-fifty basis.

The project is one of several new ventures of the UNDP in its efforts to reap the benefits of the treasures lying under the world's oceans.

Other projects involving mineral development — an effort aimed at creating new revenue sources for the developing nations — have been recently announced for Honduras, Liberia, Mauritania, Panama, Rwanda, Turkey and Upper Volta.

Each participating government is sharing the financing of the operations costing \$13.2 million.

Rwanda, in the centre of Africa, has asked for a three-year project designed to assist the government carry out aerial and ground surveys that will reveal the nation's potential mineral wealth.

Covering nearly the whole of its territory, Rwanda hopes to discover copper, lead and zinc.

Turkey's project will both lead to advance training in applied mineral exploration and intensive exploration for base and precious metals.

Upper Volta, a former French territory, is seeking to locate economic sources of water which are needed to establish manganese mining and cement industries.

Mauritania is seeking a professional geological service and the training of its staff. Panama wants help in starting the second phase of a nation-wide geological survey to reduce its dependence on the Canal for its foreign exchange. Deposits already have been discovered of copper-molybdenum.

Tin, columbite (a rare metal used in space vehicles to resist heat), iron ore, gold and other minerals are known to exist beneath Liberia's soil. The nation founded by American blacks will contribute \$344,000 toward the three year project.

Honduras is jointly funding a project similar to the one in Mauritania and calls for the establishment of a Department of Mineral Resources.

These quiet, unheralded projects may mean the world will be spared a war between the north and the south: the have-not nations below the equator against the have nations.

With a few notable exceptions (Australia, New Zealand, South Africa), the poor nations of the world lie below the imaginary line that divides the

world. But the economic state of these poor — all of whom have been victims of political and economic exploitation — is far from imaginary.

The facts bluntly show that the poor of the world are getting poorer and the rich richer. The trade gap is widening, not shrinking. (The trade gap represents the difference between what the developing nations need to buy to maintain minimum growth in terms of population and progress and what they actually can purchase.)

Officials of the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development have often stated that their greatest fear lies in the trade gap, but their warning of the consequences of not doing something about it have fallen on deaf ears.

The recent political moves affecting the UNDP reflect some of the problems of correcting the inflammable situation.

W. Germany, which has contributed 10 times as much to UN development projects as the Communist bloc combined, was recently appointed to a seat on the expanded UNDP committee which is to plan the Second Development Decade.

The Russians and their allies have announced that they will boycott the committee because the Germans are not entitled to a seat because Bonn is not a UN member.

General Assembly President Arenales, however, decided last month to the seat the Germans because he was assured of the continued, if not expanded, financial help from Bonn.

Most developing nations kept out of the fray, but they are silently supporting the decision because they have suspended politics in favor of hard cash.

Not all nations of the world are willing to accept the sacrifices that the Chinese have in building a viable economy. Mao preaches and exemplifies bootstrap development. But Mao's raw material the masses, appears to be of a different quality than most of the nations now trying to assert themselves. No one, for instance, can match the 5,000 years of Chinese history and accomplishment.

But this is not to say that the developing nations must be relegated to a permanent inferior position. The only way that seems realistic — save a war started by those who have nothing to lose — is to be seemingly unrealistic.

Massive, world-wide financial help must be forth coming and at once. The recent UNCTAD session held in New Delhi adopted a resolution, accepted by the developed nations, which would require the wealthy nations to provide at least one per cent of their annual gross national product for aiding the developing world.

But the fact remains, the funds have not been invested.

NEW YORK MOVES TO BAN THC POT

ALBANY, New York (EVO) — The New York State Assembly passed a bill which would apply penalties for possession and distribution of synthetic pot. The penalties would be the same as now enforced for the real stuff.

The bill now goes to the Senate where it is expected to be passed and sent to the governor for his anticipated approval.

But in the meanwhile, enjoy a legal high. Smoke THC.



IS THE MUSEUM A MUSEUM PIECE?

It is not particularly important to point out that things are changing, as they have always been doing so, even though the pace may be faster today. Nor is it terribly important to insist that these changes must be made as quickly as possible — they will be anyway, and there is no way of stopping them. Nor is it particularly meaningful to refer to a certain building on 53rd Street as the *Mausoleum of Modern Art*, though more and more people are referring to it in this manner. What is important, to the point of being absolutely central, is that we understand the nature of the changes which are taking place so that we know why they are necessary and can help to bring them into being as efficiently as possible.

The real question is whether museums are still necessary to us, at least in their present form. Those who imagine that museums are eternal and unchanging both as concept and institution would do well to note that the museum as we know it is rather recent in its origins. Like the concert hall, the opera house, and (to an extent) the proscenium theatre with unmoveable seats, the museum is largely a product of the nineteenth century and the upper middle class audience which patronized all these institutions. Basically the art museum was (and remains) a place one visits to commune with what are supposed to be the truly meaningful values of life and society, as distinguished from the imperfect poverty-stricken, money-grubbing world outside its walls. The museum was (and is) a place to avoid life rather than to encounter it, a place to congratulate oneself on one's values rather than to doubt them and move on to something better.

The Museum of Modern Art, and with it all forward-looking museums in the first half of this century, worked mightily and accomplished much to change the overall taste of museum-goers during that period of time. But they did almost no thing to alter the nineteenth century reasons for which people go to museums — they changed the style of display, broadened art out into crafts and design, and replaced old fashionable names with new ones,

but the museum remained the museum, a church-like place where one went to commune with all that was highest and best, a substitute temple whose holiness was guaranteed by priests turned curators.

But what happens to the museum when people get tired of visiting it for those reasons? For that matter, what happens to society when people get tired of attending proscenium theatres, concert halls, and opera houses?

All of this is now beginning to happen, and it is part of a single cultural phenomenon. The opera house was always to some extent a matter of social snobbery, while music in general, as more and more people are discovering, is more fun to listen to (or to make) at home. As for the fixed seat theatre, it has been evident for some time, particularly in its Broadway incarnation, that it is a top-heavy, bloated bore, a walking dead-man.

At the same time that these institutions are beginning to wither away, a taste for something altogether new, merging all possible genres of art, religion, therapy and enjoyment in a single, all-embracing whole, is beginning to make itself felt. It is something that will bring pleasure without guilt, social criticism without dogma, and self-development without pretension. Some of the preparatory work in this direction is already being done by environmental, mixed-media, and tech artists and by psychologists carrying out experiments in therapy along these lines. One of the results of this work will be the setting up for artificial environments fully as rich and compelling as nature at her best, though no substitute for it. These experiments are sure to be greeted with doubt and scepticism by the fearful few, and one will hear the objection that nature is being tampered with, even though the whole business of man has always been to tamper with nature — the only way of truly returning to nature is to return to the caves.

The imminence of these changes is understood in an instinctive way by many of the young and anyone else in tune with culture today. The real question is

how the museums are to go about fitting in these tendencies into their programs and concepts from another century, assuming they can fit them in — the only possible alternative is by — passing the museums altogether and breaking through into something more in touch with what is needed. It is to be hoped that the museums will understand what is happening in time and show the necessary flexibility in the face of change — it is in this light that the current protests against the Modern Museum should be understood. The direction in the arts today is towards a greater involvement of an ever-increasing number of people in far more ways than curators still thinking in dated terms are capable of imagining. It is ironic that the Modern Museum, which spent so many years of its early growth fighting against outmoded ideas of museum organization, should now find itself the object of a similar attack, but this is only one other sign among many of how fast our culture has begun to move. It is significant that the points at issue should contain not only the usual artists, complaint of too little exposure but also go on into the domain of black-white politics, environmental experiments, and general museum policy. A new point which the artists also intend to press has to do with removing those members of the museum's directorate who happen to be close relatives of important art gallery owners — it is believed that the museum is particularly vulnerable on the issue of nepotism.

However these and other matters may develop, it is not to be expected that all artists will be in agreement on all phases at all times. Disagreement among artists and critics is a normal and healthy phenomenon and one which helps, at it best, to bring about reasonable and necessary changes. What is most to be feared is not disagreement at all but the possibility that those who are in responsible positions in museums throughout this country and the world will imagine themselves to be high priests of eternal deities and so not realize the full scope and importance of what an increasingly large group of artists is now trying to tell them.

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BOOK review

Sidney Margolius, THE INNOCENT CONSUMER VS. THE EXPLOITERS, Trident Press, 1967; paperback reprint, Pocket Books, 1968, 95c.

If you have ever bought, or thought of buying, anything from a loaf of bread or can of tuna fish to a car, this book is addressed to you. It is one of the most important things ever to happen in the long cold war between consumers and those who would grab their money without giving them value received. I am surprised that it ever reached print; the NAM should have spent \$10 million to suppress it. Now that it is in print, Mr. Margolius's life insurance policy premiums are probably going to go up owing to the Unfortunate Accidents.

For this book is a merciless exposure, but a recital of facts assembled from impeccable sources) of the filthy tactics of loan sharks, land developers and credit merchandisers' motivations, accounting for the vicissitudes of the ill-fated federal consumer program under Esther Peterson, the in-packaging bill and the numerous proposals to force loan sharks to publish true annual interest rates rather than their much-publicized "Low Monthly Payments." So far from mere quoting or even from Consumer Reports, Margolius presents us with gems from trade journals like *Printer's Ink* which vilified Mrs. Peterson in language justifying a libel suit: "the most pernicious threat to advertising today," "deliberately pitting consumers against advertisers," "(consumers are) being manipulated and mistreated," "NAM's role vs. the truth-in-packaging bill is exposed as a vested interest in obscurantism, an organized fear of honesty." This notorious organization has long been a whipping-boy of liberals and radicals alike, but for once we are given explicit reasons why.

There are some quite startling historical insights here. Unscrupulous installment houses have charged low-income people from double to five times the usual prices for washing machines, TVs mattresses or especially notorious in a hitherto unsuspected degree to the mass resentment exploding in the Watts riots. During the looting, a special target was installment-account records and loan-shark commissions. The McCone investigation (euphemisms cited "easy credit" (euphemisms) as one of the major sources of trouble, deploring the tactics of merchants into heavy indebtedness — with charges, interest, repossessions, and garnishments which are usually grounds for instant firing by employers.

One need not be a devotee of health foods to recognize that when food has been "improved" by removal of vitamins (to lengthen shelf life) and by adroit doses of water or compressed air (to increase weight or bulk), the alleged improvements are costly illusions. One of the most indignant chapters has to do with what the big TV advertisers have done with the foods they are persuading the public to buy. Horrible examples abound: presweetened cornflakes are marketed at prices amounting to \$1.07 per pound for sugar alone; TV dinners which cost three times as much frozen as they would have if home-prepared, and which taste less than a third as good; frozen beef patties, which are essentially hamburger at a 250% premium; diet margarine, which is ordinary margarine diluted in equal parts with water and sold at 94c per lb.

One can understand the manufacturers' reluctance to allow the truth-in-packaging bill to become law; but not how they can sleep at night. People who cannot afford maid service are being charged for it anyway in without even the right to tell the house, but many of you sooner or later will be buying cars. Whatever you do about choosing brand and year, don't even think of reading chapter 5, "The Money Raiders," especially pages 73-79 on car financing. The amount of outright fraud, over and above what is generally excused with the smug labels of "effective salesmanship" and "sharp business practices," is unbelievable, not documented as here. It is no longer a matter of caveat emptor "let the buyer beware," it is more nearly say you peup "everyone for himself and the devil take the hindmost." A lot of this may be more or less vaguely familiar, but it is worthwhile having it spelled out. Better to know the enemy's methods when you may sooner or later have to deal with him.

The book is likely to get at least some readers to stand up and shout "Somebody DO something!" Maybe while we are waiting for an indignant congress to pass laws over lobby harassment, we can at least be forewarned. This is not paranoia; it is reality. The book ends with a roster of organizations and to providing help consumers and to merchandiser or those victimized by such sources — of the most important such buyers, for would be car or appliance buyers, at least — is credit unions, and this book doesn't tell you how to find one. (Yellow Pages? forget it.) Your best bet might be to inquire of the Consumer Cooperative Federal Credit Union, 1414 University Ave., Berkeley 94703, Calif., for the name and address of the one nearest you, and hope that it will be in the same state. One can only hope that Margolius's research will have effects as far-reaching on the retail sales and credit industries as Flexner's did on medical schools and Dix's on mental hospitals.

The need could not be more urgent.

The impossible made possible

The possible impossibility is the magic of art. Visionary Environments are programmed for a new project starting in the middle of may at a place, corner Madison Avenue and 67 Street, — called: JOHN GIBSON Projects for Commissions.

This place is less a gallery and more an office. The office of John Gibson lies on the second floor of an oldfashioned baywindowed brownstone, next to a colorful fashion boutique "For men only" and it occupies a space of about 22x22 feet. It's a nice square room. On Saturday afternoon one can find in the "office" artists, sometimes collectors, nice friendly art-chicks, just groovy people rapping ART, drinking coffee from paper cups and one can look at photos, diagrams, drawings, — sometimes also at "Samples" of art — projects hanging from the ceiling, or standing against a wall, or lying around on the windowsill — shelves. The place is informal.

It somehow reminds me of the old times, when Art was't Art — Industry yet, — let's say the Sturm Gallery in Berlin, when the little Schwitters — sculptures stood around on the windowsill, and nobody really even cared to look at them, — and everybody could have walked out with a "Schwitters" and Herwardt Walden would not even missed it . . . things had been so casual, friendly and really hip . . .

John Gibson has the ideas of a 1969 Herwardt Walden, he has changed the concept of Art — Gallery — style. He is an "Idea — Man" and says: "I'm trying to circumvent the whole gallery concept, — you could almost call me an idea broker. I am not an object merchant." Gibson nevertheless is dealing with objects, but they are monumental, gigantic, — and often they are just IDEAS for objects and projects.

On his letterhead he has printed Projects for Commissions. Last years idea — project had been "The Great Southwest Project," for an Industrial Park, "a museum without walls," occupying 3000 acres of a six — mile tract 10 minutes west of Atlanta. Over 30 outdoor sculptures have been installed. It's a pilot project for contemporary sculptures owned by American business.

Now, until March 14th a 23 year old english sculptor, Richard Long is represented with his ideas in Photoform, in the small office of Gibson. Long is a very unusual discovery. His ideas reflect the Love of Nature, love for the green lawns, trees, gardens, brooks, rivers, thickets of the English countryside. The photos exhibited are beautiful examples of the countryside. Long is "changing" with his imprints, his ideas of action *with* and *in* the landscape. The eternal nature values are Richard Long's subject matter and his mind's alertness and strategic conceptual compositions are his tools. What does Long do?

He changes the sites, with adding or removing parts of it. He belongs to the new breed of EARTH — FIRE — AIR — WATER artists, who use Nature itself for their visual experimentations. The planet, the earth itself is their laboratory. Long

bicycles around the English country and when he finds a good spot he likes, he starts to do his "Imprint" on nature. He cuts for instance on a flowery field the head of the white flowers in the shape of a long path. The effect is a pattern, white dotted flowerfield with a green stretch, a flowerless path.

Whenever Long does something to nature, placing wooden sticks in ornamental designs on a playground, arranging stones in patterns on a stony beach, ornamenting the ground in a junglewood — thicket with a white line, — or placing a flat circular ring of white wood in an open field surrounded by tall beautiful old trees, Long makes the viewer, the observer NATURE — and — FORM conscious. There is in the actions of this young english sculptor, the spirit of Henry David Thoreau and Jean Jaques Rousseau. The new romanticism of a non Tech — Art — generation is emerging . . . Nature is here to stay. PETER HUTCHINSON

March 15th Peter Hutchinson will be presented with small scale models of TEST — TUBE — sculptures — at John Gibson.

The maquettes are worked with the utmost care of a miniature — artist, dedicated to texture and the materials he uses to realize his concept and ideas. Hutchinson's ideas are those of a science — fiction dreamer. The subject matter of his models for monumental construction to be placed in open spaces (he includes even Icebergs and Vulcanos) are test — tubes, stones, mica, coal, algae, ferns, mosses, seaweed, mushrooms, bacterio — chemical — compounds. The small mock — ups he bulds by hand in his railway — flat — studio — lofs East 102th Street look like aquariums, shadow — box — displays as one can see them in botanical gardens. Hutchinson is basically a Nature — fiend, an obsessed gardener, a poetically searching chemist and lover of growing and changing things. He is also an extremely gifted writer and essayist. for Art International, Art in America (He writes in his very personal style ica, Art-philosophy Magazine). He is interested in the ideas and the phylosophy of Immanuel Velikovsky, and based some of his writings on the books "Earth in Upheaval" and "Worlds in Collision."

Hutchinson believes in the magic of science fiction, the magic of science, the magic of drugs, chemicals, decompositions, decay, transformation, the change of matter. In fact the eternal flux and change of matter is Hutchinson's myth.

To talk to Peter H. is like reading a science fiction story, or to look at a film like 2001 or Barbarella, both films Peter admires. He told me, that plants make noises, have a language, produce music, — and he is carried away by imagining what one can do, to make the plant — noises into ART. Since I talk to my own plants every day I have great sympathy for Hutchinsons Art, ideas and his phantasies.

The small sculptures, models for large scale projects consist of strangely phallic shaped test — tubes filled with all kind of growing and living matter: diminutive algae, plants, snails as tiny as small peas. Those plant — animal contents will be kept alive in self changing processes, chemically thought out by science — fiction phantast Hutchinson.

He thinks that this miniature will one day be built in gigantic size, placed on mountain tops, in valleys, at the borders of rivers, one piece is planned to be erected on Ward's Island, East River New York City. His most fictional but really absolute and universal inventions are the projects "ICEBERG" and "VULCANO."

With Iceberg a test — tube — work filled with yeast, molds, crystals etc. is designed to be placed on an Iceberg. (Continued on Page 20)

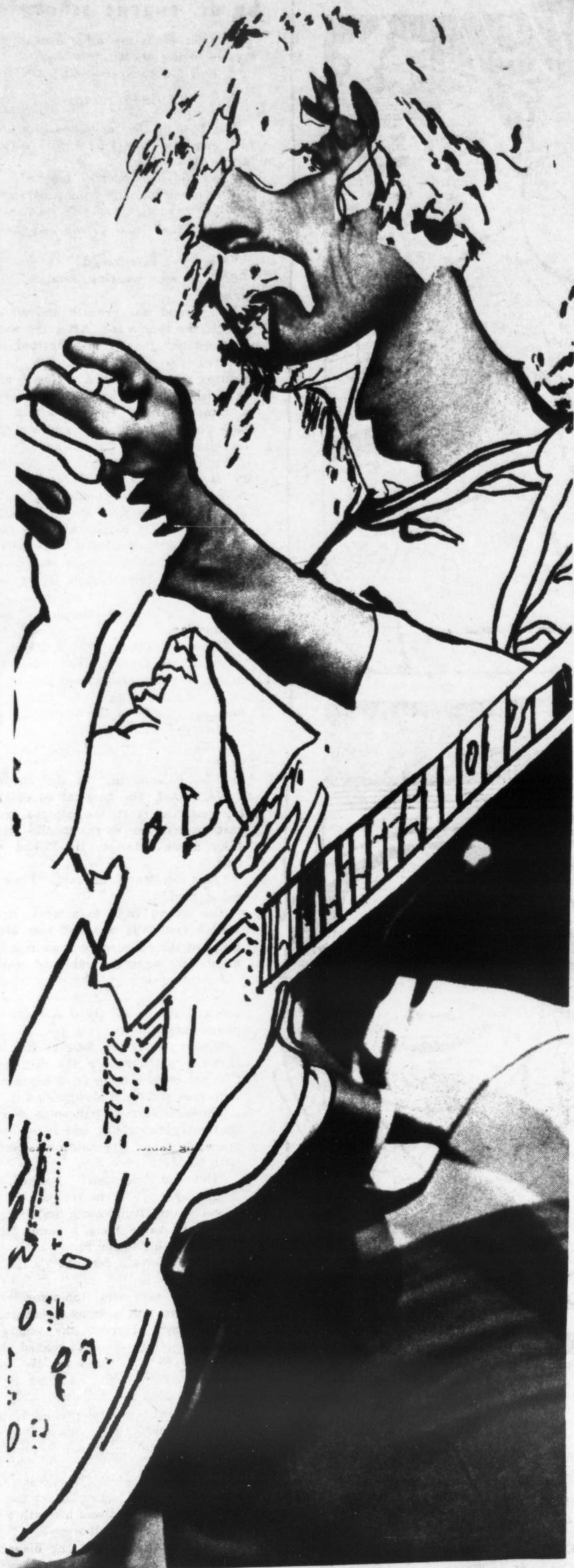

Q. — I have been studying various occult subjects for about a year now. I have a pretty good collection of books, but I want to find the most valuable (and it seems, the rarest of all; a Grimoire. Do you know where I can find a reproduction of one of the old, famous Grimoires (preferably in English). I want to copy it on parchment, bind it in wolfskin or something similar, giving me an authentic Black Book without having to kiss the devil's back side. — J.A.G.

Dear J.A.G. — The texts of various grimoires can be found in a single large fascinating volume, published originally (I think) in England and pirated in this country by the L.W. de Laurence Company sometime between the World Wars; *The Book of Black Magic and of Pacts*, by A.E. Waite. You can probably find a copy in Samuel Weiser's book shop; it is not particularly rare. You might also check for the old paper pamphlet copy of the *Lesser Key of Solomon*. The big Waite book contains not only the text of the best-known grimoires, but illustrations of various talismans and magical signs and drawings. As for copying it yourself, all the medieval magicians did this — after all, you couldn't buy them in those days, and so the only way to get a copy of a grimoire was to find someone with a copy who would let you make a copy — presumably after assuring himself that you weren't a spy for the Inquisition. If you want it particularly authentic, you can even write it with a crow's quill for a pen, make your own ink from oak-galls (any 19th century book on housekeeping will give you a recipe) and illuminate your initial letters with gold leaf. It would be a fascinating ornament for any wolf's den — excuse me — alchemist's ivory tower. It wouldn't be cheap, but at that it might come cheaper than kissing the devil's arse.

Q. — Recently I have heard of a Buddhist religious sect called Nichiren Shoshu (True Buddhists) which has been rapidly gaining converts, especially on the West Coast. From what I hear, a big feature of N.S. is the claim that one can get one's desires fulfilled by a certain chant, or at least that's what I've heard. Something compels me to try and find out more about these folks. Could you tell me (1) How they started, (2) Where they're at, and (3) your opinion of them. — E.S.

Dear E.S. — I haven't come across this sect yet, and my spies on the West Coast evidently haven't, either, so I can't make any informed commentary from the horse's mouth. (If anyone reading this column knows anything about the group, let me know and I'll print brief information here). There is nothing innately unusual about using chants as meditation symbols — that is a standard practice in what is known as Mantra Yoga. (An example of a mantra; the Tibetan Om Mani Padme Hum.) The Hare Krishna group also uses a chant (they have a record out to show you how to do it) and so do the Vedanta groups in this city and presumably elsewhere. The first of the casualties came before any confrontation. A girl with a lacerated toe.

"How did it happen?" I asked.

"Oh, I was jumping from a barricade and must of caught my foot on a nail." She was short and plump and good-humored.

"Were you bare-footed?"

"No, I was wearing sandals," she sighed.

The wound was beneath and on the side of the fourth toe. After the nurse cleansed her foot, I anesthetized and sutured the toe. Just a few nylon sutures required, but a difficult area in which to work. The girl had received a tetanus toxoid booster within the past year so didn't need another. One less jabbing.

We had been alerted to the possibility of many injuries. Several of the nurses worked a double shift that night. Three or four staff physicians were on call at home, ready to come to the hospital if needed. We waited.

Another student with an injured toe, this time a tall slender fellow with camera slung over his shoulder. He'd been taking photographs for the *Daily Californian*.

"How did it happen?" I asked

"I jumped from a barricade." One of his toes was dislocated, jutting out at a strange angle. I injected an anesthetic, reduced the dislocation, and ordered x-rays in the morning.

"That looks better," he said. The nurse taped the toe to an adjacent one and he hobbled out of the hospital.

We waited. The hospital administrator returned from the campus police station and sat down at the second floor nurses' station. He looked worried.

"Man Oh Man," he said, "They are really mad."

The second sit-in in a week. Sproul Hall a few days ago and now Moses. Some of the police were thumping their nightsticks against tables and walls.

I went upstairs to the doctors' quarters and tried to sleep. Maybe I did for an hour or so. At 6 AM the telephone rang.

"Doctor, there are four or five state highway patrolmen in the dispensary. One has blood coming from his mouth." I dressed and went downstairs.

Three uniformed policemen were in the emergency room, one lying on the operating table. His mouth was covered with blood.

"How did it happen?" I asked.

"Hit by a brick," he replied.

One of his front teeth was chipped. The blood came from a small laceration inside his upper lip.

"Do you have a dentist?"

"Yes."

"Better see him tomorrow." The nurse gave him a tetanus booster.

A student entered the emergency room, holding a blood-soaked handkerchief to his forehead. He glared momentarily at the policeman lying a few feet away.

I removed the handkerchief from his forehead and saw a jagged laceration about an inch and a half in length.

"What happend?"

"I guess I didn't move fast enough or something. I was just on the sidelines watching and was hit with a billy-club." I ordered skull x-rays.

More police entered the dispensary. A senior staff physician joined me. She looked at the scene which now resembled a disaster area and shook her head sadly.

One of the uniformed men lay on a table too narrow for his girth. He was an old man with a huge belly and obviously had been called out of retirement.

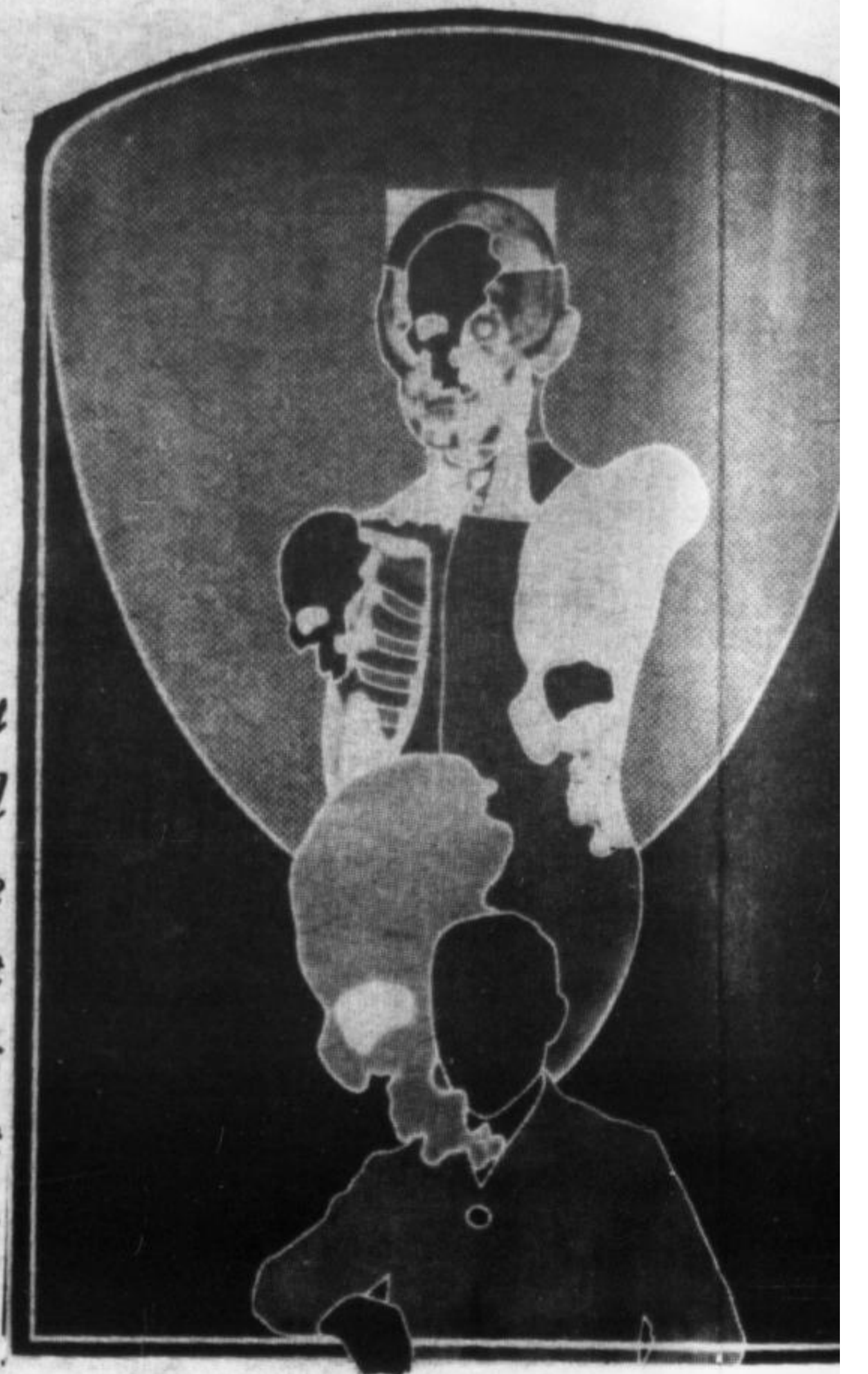

The trial of Clay Shaw brings again to a head the massive doubt that turned the post assassination trauma into a national pastime of paranoid guessing and doubtful fantasizing. No matter what the outcome of the trial in New Orleans, the whole thing remains a chessgame with the most unlikely players and the most improbable possibilities. The following is a conversation with an observer who knows all the actors in that most unlikely drama that currently plays in and around the New Orleans courthouse.



WITNESS FOR THE

As an observer who has been on the scene and who knows the principles in the case, what can you tell me about Jim Garrison's case in New Orleans?

O — I had met Ferrie and Shaw. As a matter of fact the latter was at one time my landlord. Ferrie certainly wasn't the way media depicted him. He was a brilliant, multilingual ex U-2 pilot. He was hairless because the shielding on the early U-2s was faulty. You can find a lot of bald ex U-2 pilots.

EVO — Did you know Ferrie well?

O — I didn't know him well enough to know what he really was. That I found out later. I had seen all the principles around town. New Orleans is a relatively small town.

EVO — What is your impression of Clay Shaw?

O — He is a very impressive man. He is big, quite handsome, meticulous and well mannered. He dresses well and is financially well off. His job as head of the International Trade Mart paid very well but then he also made some very good speculative buys in the French Quarter before property went up.

EVO — Do you know Jim Garrison?

O — Quite well. I had known him for years. Both of us being bar hops, we naturally met frequently in bars.

EVO — Was that before he became a District Attorney?

O — Yes and even after he was in office I saw him quite often. As I said, New Orleans is a small town and you get to know quite a few people.

He is pictured generally as a man engaged in self aggrandizement. This is really an absurdity because politically he had it made in New Orleans. He'd never be another Huey Long, but he could have easily been governor. He was considered the only downstater who could have made it. His stature was considerable. He is outrageously honest and therefore very respected. After he was sworn in as DA, he went to Bourbon Street, which is the New Orleans strip. Things were pretty bad there. An awful lot of B-drinking, the barkers were literally grabbing people and there was an awful lot of chlorhydrate. He told them to stop. Very few took him seriously. Those who didn't found their establishments padlocked. Since most of this property was owned by nice old ladies uptown, an awful lot of pressure was put on him and a lot of money was offered too. It was all in vain. The establishments that did not comply remained padlocked.

EVO — How does the political establishment in New Orleans fit into this?

O — He doesn't need them. He was a political maverick who ran outside the party structure. He was elected easily because his predecessor was a thief.

All this taken into consideration, Jim really had nothing to gain, neither politically nor personally, from the Shaw case. If he wins this case, he is not going to be very popular, if he loses he will really be a chump. But let's bear one thing in mind—he hasn't lost as yet. He has got every indictment every time he went before the grand jury. He got a conviction against Dean Andrews who was Leon's (Oswald's) attorney of sorts.

EVO — Did you know Oswald?

O — Yes, slightly. I had seen him in Bourbon House. I was a member of the ACLU and he tried to join. There was something not right about him and he was turned down. I really never gave the man another thought. He didn't seem to be the sort of man to be considered

seriously. He seemed to be a nut of course that's not how he is being viewed now.

EVO — To get back to Garrison — the remarkable thing that struck me was his ability to obtain the order by the Federal judge that ordered the release of the Kennedy autopsy X rays. This is something that few thought he could ever pull off.

O — This is currently being appealed by the government but it will probably stick. This has an interesting juxtaposition with Garrison's decision not to call Governor Connally. This is what really convinced me that Garrison was on the right track. Have you ever been in combat?

EVO — Yes.

O — Now consider the following situation — There is a shot, then another. You discover that you have been hit and then you say: "Oh my God, they are going to kill us all". Consider this very seriously and very carefully.

Another thing to consider is the fluctuation in the market value of I. G. Farben stock on the N. Y. Stock exchange on the day preceding President Kennedy's assassination.

All I can do is restructure some of the details and I believe that the picture that will evolve will shed considerable light on the whole affair.

EVO — When you mention the I. G. Farben stock, are you alluding to Allan Dulles's law firm of Sullivan-Cromwell that represented I. G. Farben for years?

O — Yes.

EVO — As one who has observed, seen and quite evidently gave much thought to it, what structure, sequence and interrelationship between the various characters come to your mind?

O — That is very difficult to say. I usually don't let myself do that because then I might have to consider myself the nut I don't believe to be. Let's go back to November 25th, 1963, the Monday after the assassination. Garrison had on that day warrants for the arrest of David Ferrie, Clay Bertrand, Gordon Novell and others.

EVO — What was the charge against these people?

O — Conspiracy. Conspiracy to commit a crime.

EVO — Was there a warrant for Clay Shaw?

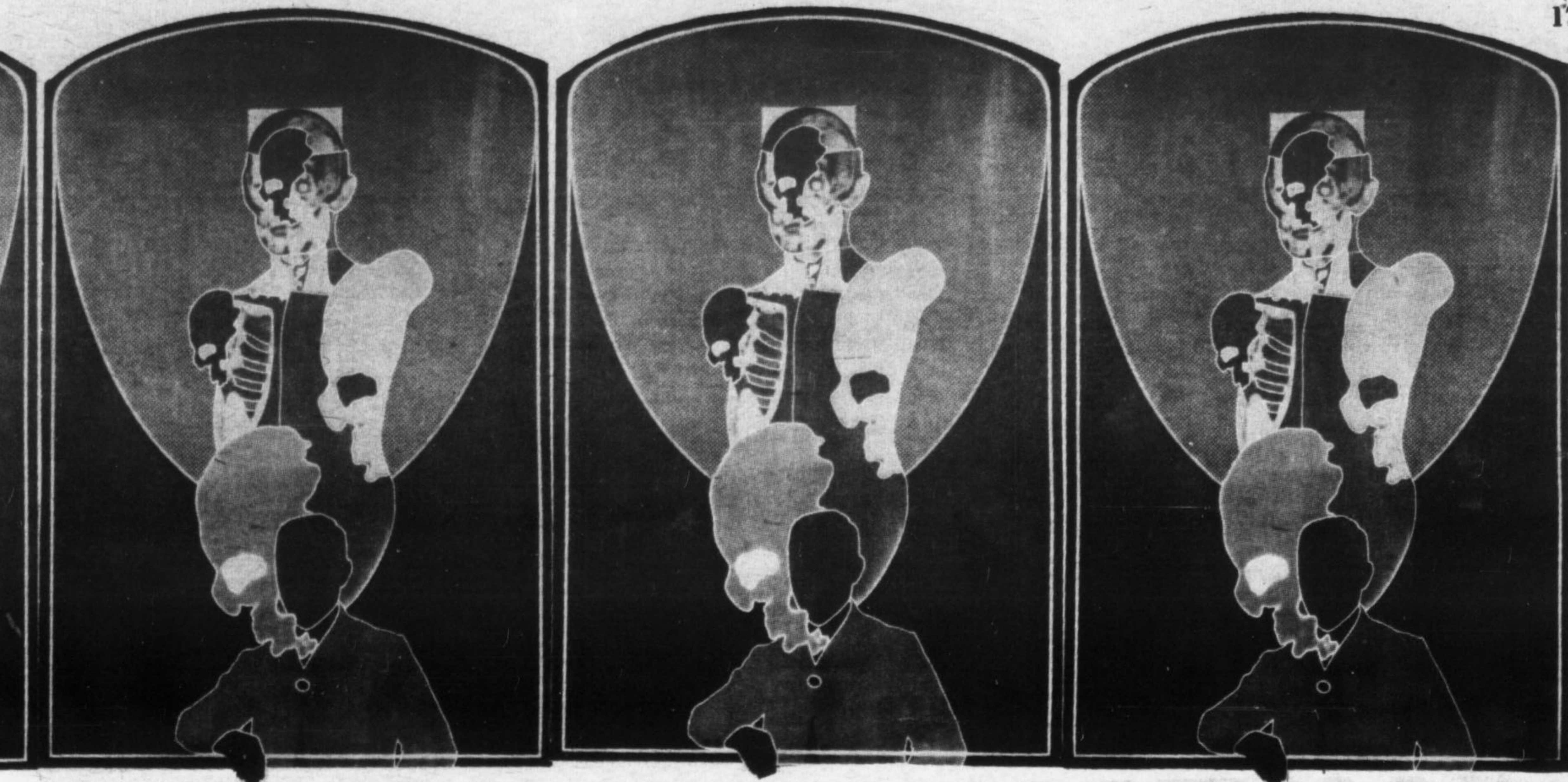
O — Not as far as I know. The warrant I mentioned was for Clay Bertrand. I don't believe that I made the connection at the time. One of those warrants was for the older brother of the then ACLU chairman in New Orleans. His name was ZERVIGON and was related by marriage to a family had large sugar plantations in Cuba that were nationalized by Castro.

EVO — Would you consider that a link to the Cuban exiles?

O — Definitely. There is no doubt that the Cubans were very much in the picture.

EVO — What happened to those warrants? Were those people ever arrested?

O — No they weren't. The day after Jim obtained the warrants the FBI got hold of him and asked him not to serve the warrants, which he did in good faith. He evidently felt that way until Hale Boggs asked him to reopen the investigation. During the three years that passed since the assassination he didn't do a thing about it. Perhaps Naively he assumed that the Federal investigative agencies were doing what they were supposed to do.

EVO — Where does Representative Hale Boggs fit in?

O — Hale Boggs was a member of the Warren Commission. A friend from college, who was then doing very extensive investigative work for a CBS Special on the Warren report, told me that during his snooping in Washington he began to find a path that proceeded him every step he took. He kept seeing tracks ahead of him. When he finally found out who it was, it turned out to be Jim's man researching the archives in lieu of the warrants that Jim was preparing. When my friend came to New Orleans and hipped me on to what was going on, it was a complete surprise. Just as he was preparing to leave, Rosemary James' article appeared in the ITEM breaking the story. When the CBS program appeared hardly any of my friend's material was used. I understand that Cronkite was personally responsible for the omissions. In the preparation of that program, CGS spent a great deal of money, part of which was used to bribe a number of Dallas policemen. They went through the whole ballistic thing. They reconstructed the whole assassination sequence and evidently convinced themselves that it couldn't possibly have been done the way the Warren Commission said it was done.

EVO — Let's get back to New Orleans. What is the connecting link between Shaw, Ferrie, Oswald, the Cubans, I. G. Farben and Dulles?

O — The first three were of course all CIA agents. Clay Shaw, David Ferrie and Leon Oswald. It is on record that as an aftermath of a CIA screwup in Italy, Clay Shaw was deported by the Italian Government. David Ferrie was, as I said, a former U-2 pilot and Oswald was beyond any doubt involved with the CIA. The same applies to the rest. I have tried to avoid setting up a specific setup in my mind in order to avoid seeing other things. The IG Farben stock comes to mind. I have yet to find anyone who could dispute as to what happened to it on the day that preceded the assassination. It is evident that someone knew what was about to happen. Keith Funston, the former head of the N. Y. Stock Exchange certainly thought so.

EVO — Where does Garrison stand today. What has happened to the man in the course of his transition from what he was to what he is now?

O — Nothing, because as far as I could see, he is the same man.

EVO — Untouched by paranoia? I have seen statements that he made in which he mentioned carrying arms and some talk about life expectancy that smacked of outright paranoia.

O — This may be so but then it is very difficult not to become paranoid if you are going to take at face value a great many of the things that exist around this case.

EVO — To what do you attribute Garrison's decision not to call Connally?

O — I think that the threat to call Connally might have had something to do with the release of the X Rays. I think it is obvious that Connally would have been a hostile witness but is also evident that Connally is a pretty broken man. A good powerful interrogator such as Jim might have easily broken him on the stand.

EVO — There are so many obviously fragile links in the prosecution's case (the junkie and Perry Russo) that one remains puzzled.

O — I agree, but then his strategy is often so unpredictable.

EVO — What do you know about Clay Shaw's S and M scene?

O — Nothing much except that he was a known fag. Probably more fop than fag, but that has very little to do with the case. When

Garrison's people went over to his place, they took the whips, and the chains as evidence. Shaw failed in his varied suits to recover these objects. He took it all the way to the Supreme Court, but lost there too. The Warren court agreed that Shaw's civil rights were not violated and that he hadn't been unduly persecuted. You keep reading about the ruination of Clay Shaw which is totally untrue. He is as wealthy as he ever was. His stock has probably gone up in the S and M crowd and his reputations among his socially prominent friends seems to be untarnished.

Now consider Jim Garrison's mandate as the District Attorney of the Parish of Orleans. When he suspects that a crime has been committed it is his duty to "gather evidence, submit it to the grand jury, obtain a warrant and secure a conviction". That is all he has done. If the securing of a grand jury indictment amounts to "capricious ruination" then the grand jury is guilty of the same. The whole picture of Garrison as presented by the media is ridiculous and whether or not he has political motives is not even germane.

EVO — The thing that still interests me is what has happened to the man himself. Where does his perseverance come from? At times one gets the impression that he is completely one track minded about it.

O — Do we consider how many cases Jim has tried during the past two years? How many other convictions has he gotten? Does anybody complain about the way he discharges his duties as the DA of the Parish of Orleans? Does anybody ever mention this? All I know is that nobody has as yet complained of him being derelict in his duties. New Orleans digs him. They think that he is a man who does his job. He has made a couple of statements that might be misleading. When he said "We have the evidence, we will get indictments and we will obtain convictions". That may sound like a statement of a mad arrogant man, yet that's exactly what he was elected to do.

EVO — I think that the Hale Boggs episode is curious. How did this happen?

O — On a plane to Washington. Due to an unexplained mixup in reservations, Jim found himself seated next to Hale Boggs. What transpired there is pretty much of a mystery but upon his return to New Orleans, Jim reopened the case.

EVO — What do you think about the outcome of the trial?

O — There is no reason to speculate about the outcome. It is almost immaterial whether Clay Shaw will be convicted or not. What is important is that previously suppressed evidence is coming to light.

EVO — From a legal point of view the case is something else again. Garrison's courtroom tactics are almost a mystery. Every success is counteracted by seeming idiocies. When that happens everybody seems to lean back and take a deep breath and bang, out of nowhere the Zapruder films suddenly come into public domain. Through it all the judge is consistent in rulings favorable to Garrison. What interests me is what makes this weird organism tick.

O — Why do you say weird?

EVO — Because there are so many blatantly contradicting factors involved.

O — Isn't that why we have our system of jurisprudence?

EVO — Have you ever been involved in a court case?

O — No, I haven't.

the old one. No copies of the changes were sent to Rabinowitz. (Selective Service claims that this was all an "inadvertant" error).

When questioned about this peculiar procedure by Nat Weber, a reporter for the CHELSEA-CLINTON NEWS, Capt. Maher denied that there was anything irregular about his action. "We have to review the minutes of the local board prior to trial," he said. "If we feel the local board's original minutes were not clear, we suggest a revision. As legal counsel to the board, we are entirely within our rights to suggest rewording to conform to legal decisions, such as the Gearey case."

"Actually," Maher continued, "the two sets of minutes said essentially the same thing; they were just worded differently." Some difference! This little sematical error could have cost Tony Fargas five years of his life!

What is interesting about the Maher interview is that he seems to admit that it is a policy of Selective Service to fix up documents when they discover that they don't have a good case against a draft objector. As for Tony Fargas, the D.A. has dropped the charges against him and has nullified his induction order. Now, he will reapply for C.O. status and pray that the local board will grant his request. What is illuminating about the board is that they could be as blind as to not recognize Tony's sincerity in the first place. Says Fargas, "I feel a certain way about violence. I feel that anybody can be a killer—that it is in us all to be killers. But we have to choose and force ourselves to be docent, non-violent, and good people. If we don't make that choice, what is going on the world will continue. But I, for one, have made my choice."

plaint sparked the warrants, which led to Gillingham's arrest and capture.

Gillingham's trial has been continued to 10 March, Monday, at 1 p.m., where he will without a doubt be convicted by Judge Bloodgood. It will by natural change sink into the water and in the new environment become something else, in a kind of eastern — philosophical — reincarnational — transitional process.

The Vulcano work is also a "destination" piece that will be transformed when the Vulcano erupts. Hutchinson has the idea to place it at the edge of the crater of Kelaue Vulcano on Hawaii Island.

Asked in the interview if the artist believes

in natural destruction he answered: "Yes."

Why do you choose snails, crystals, algae, yeast, molds?

Hutchinson replied: "Because it's simple. Those living things produce spores and I am making them grow and change. They are organic and change organically, but as an artist I also use crystals, which are not organic, the opposite, I work with the contrast."

He produces in his testtubework three types of land scapes: The organic, the decayed and the primitive growing landscape. They consist of super saturated chemical solutions that yield, (they are also crystals and tubes filled with fermenting materials that produce yeast), mold and primitive plants. The sculptures Hutchinson has in mind, in the monumental form, for which the small miniature — models are only the samples, (exhibited in March in the Gibson Gallery) are really sculpture — laboratories. Hutchinson is basically a new kind of Primitivist.

He uses the scientific processes for his work, he uses science fiction for his inspiration, and he uses his very talented able hands for formings to make the models for work, that has to be commissioned to be made by machines, to become Natural — Environmental — Sculptures.

He was born in London, England, studied Art at the University of Ill. B. F. A. 1960. Had three shows in New York before he turned to this new concept of "Growing Art in Test Tubes." Paradoxically his miniatures Test Tubes models sell like hot yeast rolls.

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Once you get used to it, his voice is really something.

Apparently, it's taking longer than we thought to get used to that voice. We put out "Randy Newman" almost a year ago. Not much happened in the record stores. When we asked him about that, our Mr. Sherman, who heads up Reprise's sales department, started changing the subject and asking when we'd be ready with the next Sinatra album.

Undaunted by this lack of rush to buy the album, we comforted ourselves with critical notices which, like they say, "glowed." We also wondered, "Are we fooling ourselves?" No, we decided, because people whose judgment we respected, like Mr. McCartney and Miss Collins and Mr. Nilsson told us "Randy Newman" was in the masterpiece category.

Where had we gone wrong?

We changed the jacket, putting the lyrics of Randy's tunes on the liner, because some people complained he sounded like Ray Charles with a sinus condition. Those people we wrote off as know nothing spoil sports. But, printing those lyrics didn't up our sales curve.

So next we wrote to people saying, listen,

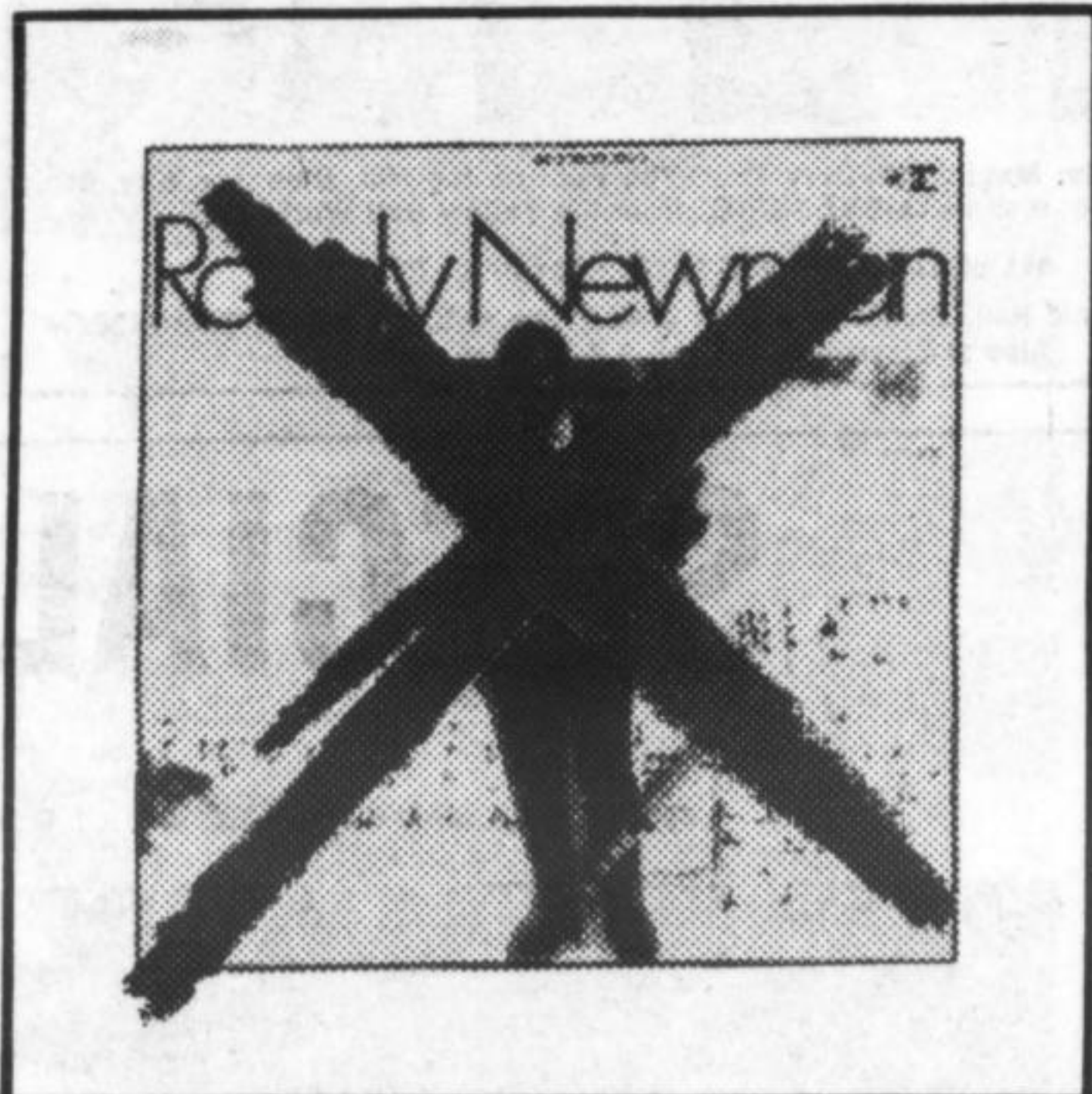
Randy's had like the #1 song in England; like at first even we didn't understand how good he is; other impressive sayings.

We're still waiting.

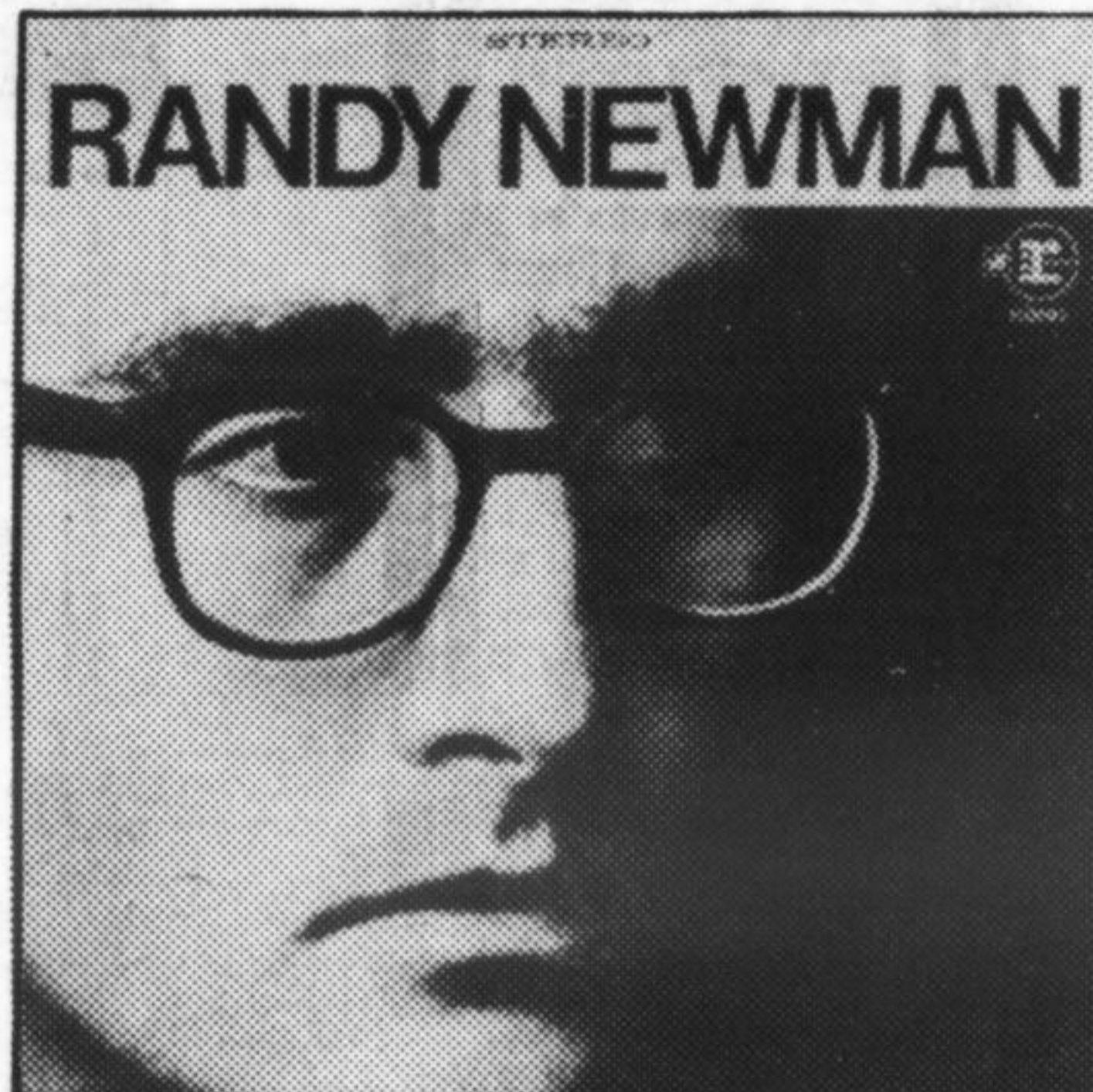
The occasion for this advertisement is that now Mr. Thrasher, our art director, has just put a new cover on the album, hoping that'll
